

High-Visibility Safety Apparel



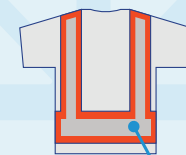
POST requires that workers wear high visibility apparel as part of their **basic personal protective equipment** when working on sites with vehicle operators.

The Canadian Standards Association Z96-15 lists three classes of high visibility apparel:

Class 1

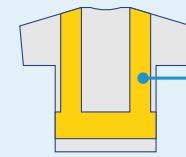
Provides the lowest recognized coverage and good visibility.

**POST accepts Class 1 and 2 for most tasks.*



Class 1 is **only** accepted by POST when part of a garment.

High-visibility retroreflective stripes (silver or white)



Combined-performance retroreflective stripes (orange/yellow)



Non high-visibility garment

Class 2

Provides moderate body coverage and superior visibility.

**Examples of Class 2 apparel includes vests, jackets and bib overalls.*



High-visibility material, fluorescent orange/yellow

Combined-performance retroreflective stripes (orange/yellow)

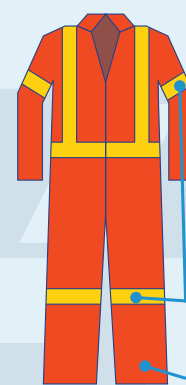


Optional arm bands

Class 3

Provides the greatest body coverage and visibility under poor light conditions and at great distance.

**Requirements vary from province to province. Check local jurisdiction.*



Most suitable for **low-light** conditions and where **vehicle operators** clearly place the worker in danger.

Arm and leg bands

High-visibility material, fluorescent orange/yellow
